GEOGRAPHY OF BRAZIL



- Brazil has 5 different geographic zones- Guiana highlands, Amazon lowlands, The Pantanal, Brazilian highlands, Coastal lowlands.
- The Brazilian highlands cover over half of Brazil's landmass at 4.5 million square kilometers.
- The Pantanal covers about 210,000 square kilometers and is 80% submerged during the rainy seasons.
- The Amazon rainforest is the worlds largest intact forest. More than 24 million people in Brazil live there.
- The 2 main physical features of Brazil are plains and plateaus.

BRAZIL'S HISTORY

- The history of Brazil begins with indigenous people that lived in Br
- The Europeans arrived in Brazil at the opening of the 16th century.
- The Portuguese were the first European settlers to arrive in the area, they were led by Pedro Cabral.
- In April 1500 Brazil was claimed for Portugal on the arrival of Portuguese fleet commanded by Pedro Cabral.
- Brazil is the only country in South America where Portuguese is the official language.



BRAZIL'S CULTURE



- The cultures of indigenous Indians, Africans, and Portuguese have together formed the modern Brazilian way of life.
- The Portuguese culture is by far the dominant culture. From it Brazilians acquired their main religion, language, and most of their customs.
- African influences on the Brazilian way of life are strongest along the coast between the northeast and Rio de Janeiro.
- Some African influences include traditional foods, religions, and popular music and dance, especially the samba.
- Commercial and cultural imports from Europe and North America have often competed with Brazilian
 cultural output, despite numerous social and economic challenges, Brazilians continue to be creative
 in their celebrations and art forms.
