- In 2006 archaeologists found ancient stones with inscriptions on them



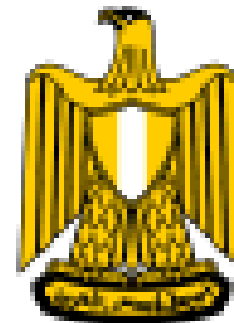
## What are some interesting facts about Egypt's culture?
