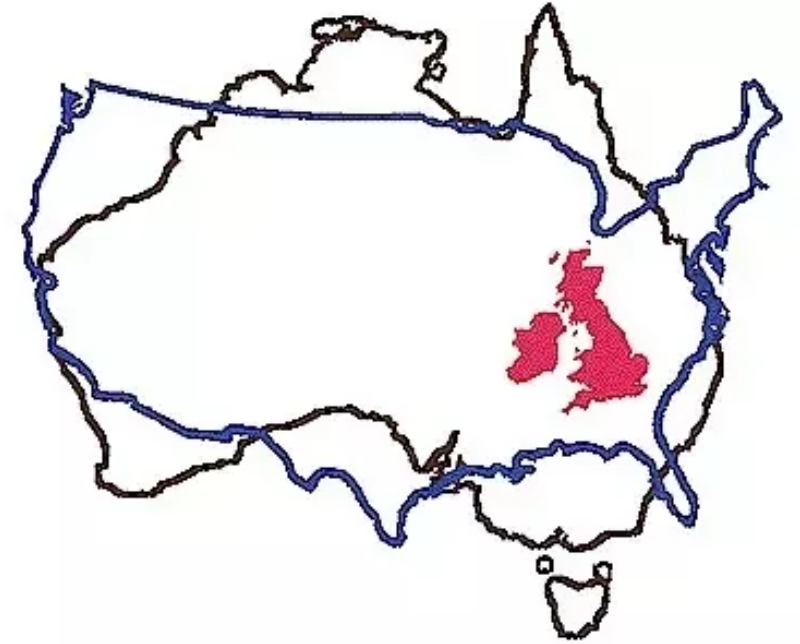


# England
