


Where is your country?

- Over 197 festivals take place in London every year including the largest free festival the <u>Mayor's</u>
 <u>Thames Festival</u>, and Europe's biggest street festival, the Notting Hill Carnival which attracts near one million people.
- 3. London dominates the UK visual arts sector, which accounts for **30**% of the global art market.
- 4. Over a **fifth** of all the UK's **cinema screens** are based in London. There are more cinema screens in the capital (911) than in any other part of the country.
- 5. In the last 10 years, London based artists Adele, Coldplay, Pink Floyd and Amy Winehouse (*RIP*) have been the world's best-selling recording


