WHERE IS LITHUANIA?

- •.LITHUANIA IS IN NORTHERN EUROPE, SURROUNDED BY LATVIA TO THE NORTH, BELARUS TO THE EAST, POLAND TO THE SOUTHWEST, AND KALINIGRAD TO THE WEST
- •.LITHUANIA HAS MOSTLY LOWLAND WITH SMALL LAKES, CAUSING FERTILE SOIL
- •.THE CENTER PLAINS ARE SURROUNDED BY HILLY UPLANDS, THAT WERE CREATED FROM ANCIENT GLACIAL DEPOSITS
- •.AROUND 30% OF LITHUANIA IS FORESTS
- •.LITHUANIA'S HILLS DON'T REACH VERY HIGH WITH THE HIGHEST ONE BEING AUKSTOJAS HILL, AT 294 METERS



LITHUANIAS INTERESTING HISTORICAL FACTS

- LITHUANIA WAS UNDER RUSSIAN RULE FROM THE LATE 18TH CENTURY TO 1918 AT WHICH LITHUANIA DECLARES ITS INDEPENDENCE, AND LATER IN 1920 IS RECOGNIZED AS INDEPENDENT BY RUSSIA.
- In 1940 the Soviet army invaded Lithuania, forcing the current president to flee and Lithuania being forced into a part of the Soviet Union.
- In 1941 Nazi Germany invades the Soviet Union and occupies Lithuania, but later in 1944 the Soviet army returns to REPRESS RESISTANCE.
- IN 1989 PARLIAMENT APPROVES A DECLARATION STATING THAT LITHUANIAN LAWS WILL TAKE PRECEDENCE OVER SOVIET ONES, AND LATER ARE RECONCILED AS INDEPENDENT BY THE SOVIET UNION.
- In 2004 Lithuania joins the EU and NATO.





LITHUANIAN CULTURE

- LITHUANIANS SPEAK OFFICIALLY LITHUANIAN, BUT ALSO SPEAK A VARIETY OF LANGUAGES
- LITHUANIA HAS MANY RELIGION WITH THE PRIMARY ONE BEING ROMAN
 CATHOLIC
- LITHUANIA CELEBRATES MANY OF THERE OWN CULTURAL HOLIDAYS SUCH AS SAINT CASIMIR'S DAY WHICH CELEBRATES THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE DEATH OF SAINT CASIMIR'S DEATH, WHO WAS THE PATRON SAINT OF LITHUANIA.
- THE MOST CULTURAL PLACE IN LITHUANIA WOULD BE VILNIUS THE CAPITAL OF LITHUANIA, WHERE ALL CULTURAL PARTS OF LITHUANIA RESIDE.
- RELIGION IS VERY IMPORTANT TO LITHUANIANS AND A SITE OF THAT WOULD BE THE HILL OF CROSSES A VERY SIGNIFICANT RELIGIOUS HILL WITH MANY CROSSES SET UP.
