- German Wurst or Sausage is a big part of the German Culture. They can be made from Pork, Beef and Veal and their flavor can differ.



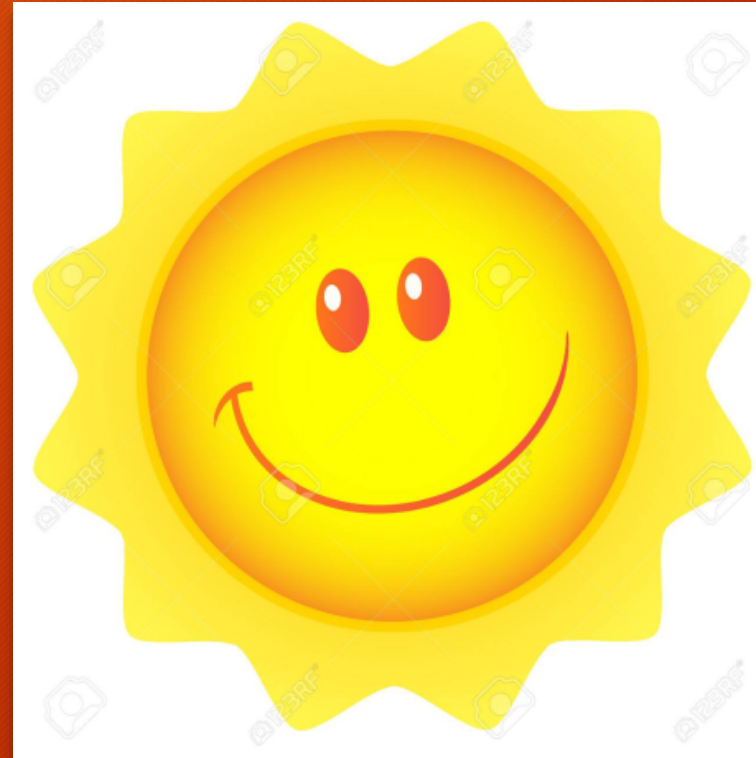
What I like best about Germany
