# Geography of Nigeria

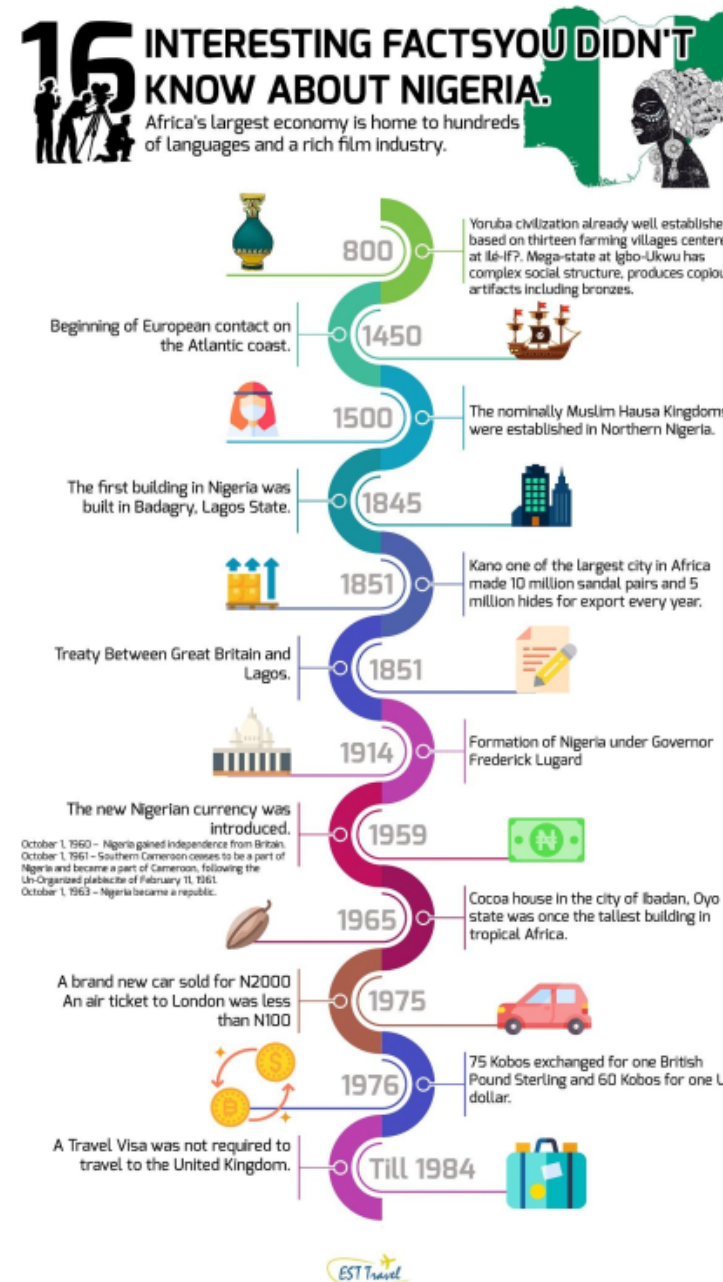
- ▶ Nigeria is a distinctive regions and it including deserts, plains, swamps, mountains, and steamy jungles
